

Bikali College, Dhupdhara was provided a post-graduate correspondence school (PGCS) contact centre under Gauhati University in the academic session 2003-2004. The main objective is to cover the vast number of student who, due to limited number of seat in post graduate classes or for other reasons cannot enrol themselves in the coventional admission system of the university. The P.G.C.S.

contact centre in Bikali college always strives to provide an opportunity to those eligible local and near by student, sevrice holder who missed the opportunity earlier to pursue higher education. Bikali College centre authorised to admit students on behalf of PGCS, G.U. student can also recieve all kind of necessary information regarding admission process, stydy material, personal contact programme examination and other examination and other matters from this centre. Students who are interested for higher education in the following courses, they can come in the time of admission with relevant document and take admission on the spot through the centre.

The M.A./M.Sc/ M.Com programme under PGCS, G.U. shall be of two years duration (two academic years) and divided into two parts, previous and final. The M.A./M.Sc courses in assamese, Bengali, English, Economics, History, political science, recognised Indian or Foreign Universities having the relevant subject at degree level. On the other hand, post graduate diploma in sales and marketing management (PGDSMM), post graduate diploma in human resource management

(PGDHRM) & post graduate diploma in business management programme PGDBM) under PGCS, G.U. shall be of one year duration, i e. one academic year. The above mentioned management courses are open to any graduate from recognised Indian or Foreign Universities/ Institutes in any stream .Candidate who are pursuing another degree course in this university are also eligible for simultaneous admission. PGCS, G.U. has allowed to Bikali College centre to open for admission two other courese like post graduate in computer application (PGDCA) and post graduate diploma in journalism and mass communication (PGDJMC) recently but, due to nonavailability of in frastructural facility, the centre is not able to allow for admission in the above mentioned two courses till now. Wecan expect that in near future these course will exist in our college benifit of the students

The total fees for M.A./ M.Sc/ M. Com courses shall be Rs 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) for previous and final year as dicided by PGCS, G.U. The fees are payable either in one or two equal material fee, library fee, postal charge, and the examination fee etc. The admitted student in our centre use the college library as prior permission of the college authority concerned.

The total fees for above mentioned management course shall Rs 6000/- (Ru-

pees six thousand only) inclusive admission fee, counselling fee, course material fee, library fee, postel charge and examination fee etc. The fee are payable either in one or two equal instalment as decided by the PGCS, G.U.

We expect that Bikali college centre will be able to stand as one of the major contact centre as well as study centre under PGCS, G.U. in near future.

The Role of Bikali College in Disaster Risk Management Programme

From a few years past Government of India has been prompting the awareness of the people regarding the hideous sequel of disaster, may be Natural or Man made. Though, this consciousness has been palpitating spontaneously in everyone's heart, but there has been hardly any national level invigoration - that is methodical, systematic and recorded. Now, the Govt of India takes some drastic steps to prevent natural or man made disaster and its affect as for as possible under human limitation. Under the tenth five years plan,

the Govt of India has been accepting a disaster risk management programme in the national level. They have sorted out 169 multi hazard prone disctricts in 17 states, and the entire North East is considered as the highest sensitive zone in the national earth-quake map.

Thus, keeping relevance with this programme. Bikali College, Dhupdhara participated in an orientation programme held in the Goalpara College on 12th Nov, 2006. This programme was organized by the Disaster Risk Management Cell of Goalpara College in collaboration with Deputy Commissioner and the Election officer of Goalpara distric. To this programme Prof. Bhupati Das, Prof. Ramesh ch. Das, Prof. Pankaj Rabha and Prof. Prasanta Pathak represented for Bikali College Disaster Risk Management cell. In this programme several plans, principles and strategies were discussed about pre-disaster, during disaster and post - disaster.







