



## BACKGROUND OF THE COLLEGE

*B*ikali College is the seat of higher learning in the easternmost border of Goalpara district. The College was established on 14<sup>th</sup> April, 1982. It is the outcome of selfless dedicated service of the rural masses of fifty four villages, which constitutes "Bikali Mouza Unnayan Samiti" - a socio- cultural Non- Governmental Organization.

#### 1.1 NOMENCLATURE OF THE COLLEGE

The College is named after "Bikali Mouza" or "Dihi", which is part of the historical "Habraghat Pargana".

#### **1.2 LOCATION**

The College is located at Dhupdhara, a small market township of Bikali Mouza area. It is 0.75 km. away from N.H. 17 and Dhupdhara Railway Station. The College is under Rangjuli Tribal Development Block, Rangjuli revenue circle and 36- Dudhnoi ST Reserved L.A.C. (constituency) in Goalpara district of Assam.

#### 1.3 COLLEGE CAMPUS

The College has a spacious campus. The campus extends and sprawls out in consonance with the rural environment. Most of the buildings have been modeled and constructed keeping a view the future landscape and also to harmonize well with the rural setting in the sylvan grandeur. At present the college built-up area is more than 2.5 hectares out of 7 hectares of total land area. Of these 4.5 hectares is covered by playground and different plantation schemes.

#### 1.4 STREAM

The institution offers arts, commerce, science courses at the Higher Secondary Level and major in almost all the subjects have been introduced at Under Graduate level. P.G. course in Assamese and Geography has been successfully introduced along with career oriented programmes.

#### 1. 5 AFFILIATION AND DEFICIT

The College has been affiliated to Gauhati University since the 1988-89 session. The College was brought under Deficit -Grants -in Aid System in 1992 and presently under provincialised system of Govt. of Assam (2005) . The college has been registered under UGC 12 (B) with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> plan.

#### 1.6 NAAC RE-ACCREDITATION

The College has been re-accredited (Third-cycle) by NAAC in 2016-17 and was awarded "B" grade.

#### **1.7 IQAC**

For the process of monitoring the development of the College, an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established under the guideline of NAAC. The cell has its own Website for academic audit and linkage with NAAC and other agencies. Moreover, the website is updated at regular intervals.

#### 1.8 OTHER AIDS

The "Bikali Mouza Unnayan Samiti" - a socio-cultural organization is the major contributor to the College in every aspects of development. Besides, "Tin Daliya Raiz", Dhupdhara, Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council, Gaon Panchayats and a large number of individual benevolent donors have contributed for its development. The Integrated Tribal Development Project has also been granting scholarship to tribal students for their welfare and upliftment.

#### INCENTIVES, FACILITIES AND WELFARE ACTIVITIES

#### 4.1. INCENTIVES FOR MERITORIOUS AND NEEDY STUDENTS:

Packages of incentives for meritorious as well as needy students have been offered by the college authority since a couple of years. Five meritorious students will be selected on the basis of the conditions laid down by the authority. Selection will be from those students who have secured more than 60 percent of marks.

#### 4.2. FACILITIES AVAILABLE:

(A) GAMES AND SPORTS: Football playground, Volleyball ground, Badminton court, Cricket ground, practice ground for archery are available. Besides, the College also has a mini stadium.

INDOOR GAMES FACILITIES: Facilities for Badminton, Chess, Carom, Arm Wrestling, Weight Lifting are available.

(B) ART AND CULTURE: The College provides facilities to the students interested in art and culture by arranging cultural programmes, get together, festival and college week. Besides, the college also provides scope to participate in extracurricular activities, competitions, youth festivals organized by G.U. and also other sociocultural organizations.

#### 4.3. LIBRARY:

The College library is placed in a calm and quiet environment with moderately high collection of text books, reference books of all subjects along with journals and newspapers for regular use of the teachers and students. The library has a well furnished reading room equipped with reading stand for students. The students are allowed to go through books, journals, news papers, bulletins in the reading room during the college hour. Two books for General course students and three books for Major course students are issued for a specific time. The borrower of the book will be responsible for any damage or loss of the book. Needy students are also issued books under 'Book Bank' Scheme. Besides, reading facilities especially for Competitive Examination is also available in the library. The College library has been computerized for smooth management and systematic functioning. A cell on 'Gandhian Study' has also been, started in the library. Apart from these, a distinctive cell on local publication is also coming up.

#### 4.3.1 DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY:

All the departments have libraries which are linked with the central library.

- **4.3.2: DIGITAL LIBRARY**: The College has a well –equipped Digital Library which can cater the students in meeting up excessive course materials and for picking up more information immediately.
- **4.3.3. WEB-SITE LIBRARY:** The College has a WEB-SITE Library which is available for the students for accessing internet, practice and preparation of projects.
- **4.3.4. WI-FI FACILITY:** Students are provided with Wi-Fi facility for accessing internet at zero cost.
- **4.3.5. PHOTOCOPIER POINT:** A photocopier point is also available inside the Central Library of the College which provides photocopy facility to the students as well as faculty members.
- **4.4: SMART CLASSROOM:** The College has provided SMART CLASSROOM system by keeping hand in hand with modern technology which is equipped with microphone facility, smart board, LCD projector etc.
- **4.5: CONFERENCE ROOM:** The College has a round table conference room designed with beautiful infrastructure, fully air-conditioned with LCD projection and purified drinking water facilities.
- **4.6: TRAVEL CONCESSION:** Student can avail Railway travel concession for their academic purpose journey as well as educational excursion etc.

- **4.7: GREEN HOUSE:** A miniature green house (cold frame) is initiated in the College premise in view of future larger scheme where various flower plants and other medicinal plants are planted for nourishment in different seasons.
- **4.8 AQUATIC ECO-SYSTEM:** A fresh water aquatic eco-system is conceptualized as well as started in the College premise for the projection of miniature aquatic eco-logical system.

#### COLLEGE RULES AND MANAGEMENT

- 4. Students must appear at the examinations conducted by the academic bodies, such as class test, unit test, Pre-final test and Final Examinations.
- 5. Students found to have consumed intoxicating drinks, drugs, tobacco and indulged in immoral activities shall be liable to expulsion.
- 6. Students shall have to obey the Rules and Regulations as may be prescribed by college, AHSEC and by Gauhati University authorities.
- 7. Any student indulging in ragging or involved in any such act is liable to expulsion from the College.
- 8. Decision of Governing body and Disciplinary committee in all matters relating to students indiscipline shall be final and binding.


